At the conclusion of the semester, the adult ensembles gather for an informal sharing.

The "Evenings of Chamber Music" is a program designed strictly for adult groups. Each evening consists of 2 sessions: one for rehearsal/reading time, and one for coaching. Informal sharing on last evening.

Dr. Emily Butterfield, a CMC Associate Faculty Member, is beginning her third year as CMC's Adult Program Coordinator. Also on the faculty of Muskingum College and Mt. Vernon Nazarene University, Dr. Butterfield, a flutist, performs in area chamber and large ensemble venues including the Central Ohio Wind Quintet and the Schullhoff Trio. In 2005 she was a featured soloist in CMC's Conservatory Concert Series.
